\$2 million allocated to save precious lives

During this fiscal year, **Israel Magen Fund of Canada (IMFoC)** continued to strengthen its role as a trusted Canadian charity dedicated to advancing healthcare, emergency response, mental health, and resilience initiatives in Israel.

Working with **eight partner organizations and institutions**, while continuing to expand that network, we maintained rigorous oversight through comprehensive direction and control, regular monitoring, and semi-annual project monitoring visits.

Our activities are overseen by an experienced Board of Directors, executive leadership team, and dedicated volunteers. Our new CEO, Shiri Lidai, a lawyer licensed in both Canada and Israel, brings extensive legal expertise and a strong understanding of IMFoC's mission, operations, and partnerships in Israel, further strengthening our commitment to sound governance, accountability, and regulatory compliance. Operating with a lean team and highly efficient model, IMFoC continues to maximize the proportion of donor funds directed toward charitable activities.

This year, more than \$2 million, net of expenses, was allocated to initiatives supporting life-saving medical equipment, emergency response capabilities, resilience centres, and mental health programs.

Our operations, financial statements, and charitable activities remain transparent and publicly available. Together with our donors, volunteers, and partners, we are creating measurable, life-changing impact where it is needed most.

Strengthening Healthcare Through Life-Saving Medical Equipment

Access to advanced medical equipment can mean the difference between uncertainty and hope, between delayed treatment and timely intervention, and even between life and death.

Through the generosity of IMFoC donors, critical healthcare initiatives have strengthened hospitals' capacity across Israel to deliver faster diagnoses, more precise treatments, and specialized care for patients at every stage of life.

These investments are not simply purchases of technology; they are investments in people, families, and communities who depend on their local hospitals during some of life's most vulnerable moments.

CO₂ Laser Technology

This year, donor support helped provide advanced CO₂ laser technology to Ziv Medical Center, strengthening its ability to perform highly precise ENT procedures with reduced complications and faster recovery times. The equipment has already enabled life-changing treatments, including a vocal cord procedure that restored a patient's ability to speak and significantly improved his quality of life. This investment will continue to benefit patients across northern Israel by expanding access to specialized care closer to home.

Surgical Ultrasound System

Among the many initiatives supported this year, IMFoC helped equip Ziv Medical Center with an advanced surgical ultrasound system that enhances diagnostic accuracy and supports safer, more effective surgical procedures.

Serving more than 500,000 residents in northern Israel, the hospital can now provide faster interventions and improved treatment outcomes for thousands of patients each year. By helping physicians make critical decisions in real time, this technology is strengthening healthcare delivery and improving patient care across the region.





The Future of Israel: In Our Hands

IMFoC's annual neonatal campaign successfully strengthened life-saving care for newborns across Israel.

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, advanced neonatal equipment was provided to hospitals serving approximately 32,200 babies each year, helping ensure that Israel's most vulnerable patients receive the critical care they need for a healthier start in life.

Neonatal Care Equipment

Thanks to the generosity of donors who supported IMFoC's "The Future of Israel: In Our Hands" campaign, critical neonatal care equipment was provided to hospitals across Israel.

Through this initiative, Ziv Medical Center received three open incubator and resuscitation station units, Soroka Medical Center received six ThermoCare K infant warmers, and Mayanei Hayeshua Medical Center received one transport incubator.

Together, these life-saving systems support hospitals that care for approximately 32,200 newborns each year, including an estimated 1,200 babies who require emergency medical attention immediately after birth.

For these vulnerable infants, many born prematurely or facing serious medical complications, the first minutes of life are critical. Access to advanced neonatal equipment allows healthcare teams to provide immediate warming, monitoring, stabilization, and emergency resuscitation when every second counts.

Thanks to donor support, more than a thousand newborns each year have access to the specialized care they need during their most fragile moments, giving them the strongest possible start in life.

For the medical teams who care for these infants and the families who anxiously wait beside them, this equipment represents far more than technology. It represents preparedness during emergencies, confidence during moments of uncertainty, and hope for a healthy future. Every newborn who receives the care they need because of this equipment is a powerful reminder of how donor generosity saves lives and strengthens communities for generations to come.

Equipping Heroes to Save Lives

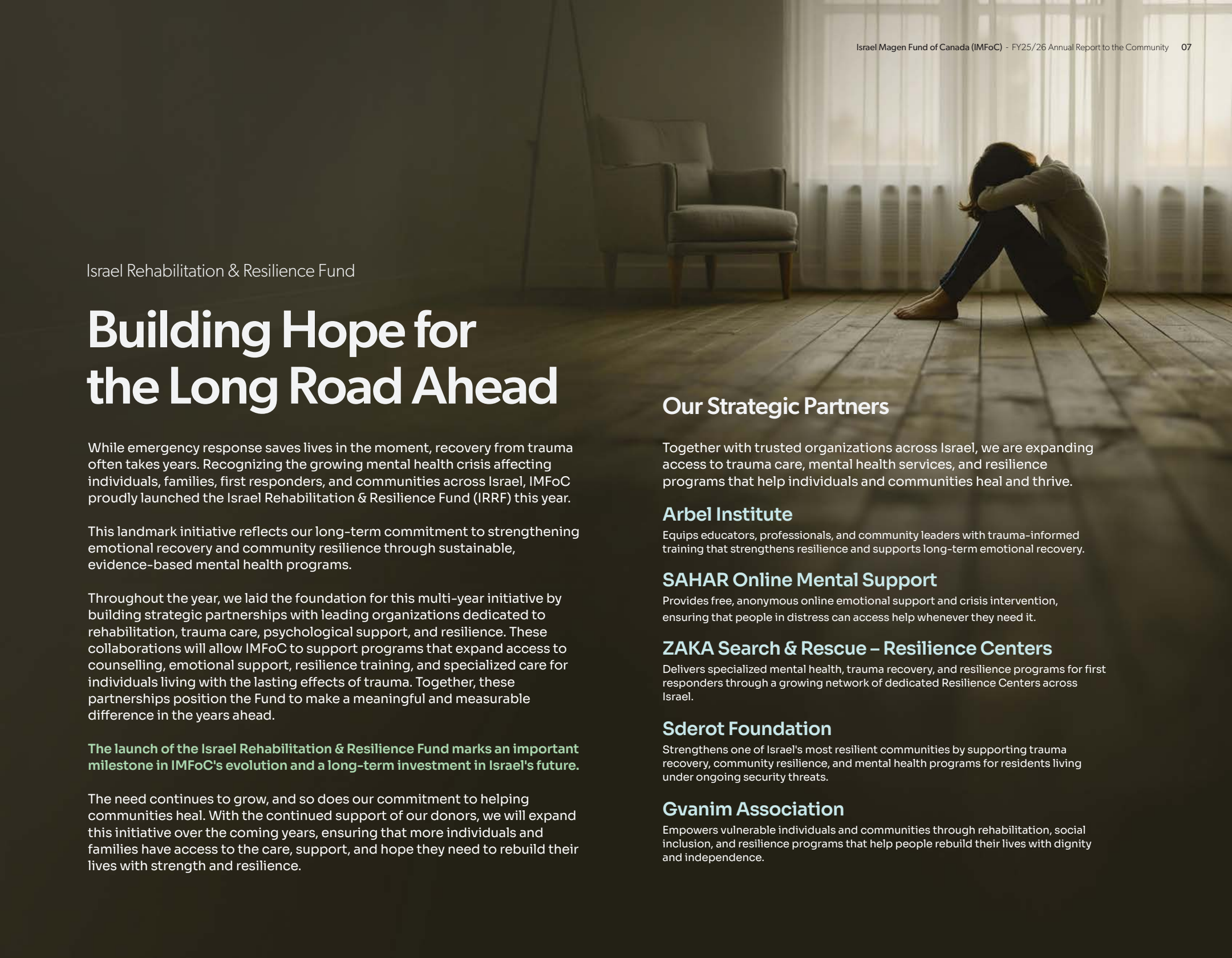
This year, thanks to a donor's generosity, IMFoC helped strengthen Israel's emergency response capabilities by supporting the deployment of a fully equipped WD4 rescue vehicle operated by ZAKA Search & Rescue.

This life-saving asset enables faster access to emergencies, quicker evacuations, and more rapid delivery of critical assistance when every second matters.

At the same time, IMFoC continued supporting the ZAKA Resilience Unit, which provides mental health and psychological support for ZAKA volunteers facing the immense emotional challenges of responding to traumatic incidents, disasters, and mass-casualty events. By strengthening this vital program, we are helping ensure that those who dedicate their lives to saving others receive the care they need to continue their mission.

While these achievements represent meaningful progress, they are only the beginning. Much of ZAKA's emergency response fleet still requires replacement and modernization to meet growing operational demands. With your continued support, we can help ensure that more first responders have the equipment, resources, and resilience they need to save lives when communities need them most.

Israel Rehabilitation & Resilience Fund

Building Hope for the Long Road Ahead

While emergency response saves lives in the moment, recovery from trauma often takes years. Recognizing the growing mental health crisis affecting individuals, families, first responders, and communities across Israel, IMFoC proudly launched the Israel Rehabilitation & Resilience Fund (IRRF) this year.

This landmark initiative reflects our long-term commitment to strengthening emotional recovery and community resilience through sustainable, evidence-based mental health programs.

Throughout the year, we laid the foundation for this multi-year initiative by building strategic partnerships with leading organizations dedicated to rehabilitation, trauma care, psychological support, and resilience. These collaborations will allow IMFoC to support programs that expand access to counselling, emotional support, resilience training, and specialized care for individuals living with the lasting effects of trauma. Together, these partnerships position the Fund to make a meaningful and measurable difference in the years ahead.

The launch of the Israel Rehabilitation & Resilience Fund marks an important milestone in IMFoC's evolution and a long-term investment in Israel's future.

The need continues to grow, and so does our commitment to helping communities heal. With the continued support of our donors, we will expand this initiative over the coming years, ensuring that more individuals and families have access to the care, support, and hope they need to rebuild their lives with strength and resilience.

Our Strategic Partners

Together with trusted organizations across Israel, we are expanding access to trauma care, mental health services, and resilience programs that help individuals and communities heal and thrive.

Arbel Institute

Equips educators, professionals, and community leaders with trauma-informed training that strengthens resilience and supports long-term emotional recovery.

SAHAR Online Mental Support

Provides free, anonymous online emotional support and crisis intervention, ensuring that people in distress can access help whenever they need it.

ZAKA Search & Rescue – Resilience Centers

Delivers specialized mental health, trauma recovery, and resilience programs for first responders through a growing network of dedicated Resilience Centers across Israel.

Sderot Foundation

Strengthens one of Israel's most resilient communities by supporting trauma recovery, community resilience, and mental health programs for residents living under ongoing security threats.

Gvanim Association

Empowers vulnerable individuals and communities through rehabilitation, social inclusion, and resilience programs that help people rebuild their lives with dignity and independence.

Our Oversight Process

1 Identifying Community Needs

We assess medical, humanitarian, and community needs with partner organizations to identify priorities and expected impact.

2 Due Diligence & Validation

We review budgets, documentation, organizational capacity, compliance requirements, and technical needs to ensure projects are feasible and effective.

3 Formal Agreements

Written agreements define project scope, approved use of funds, timelines, reporting obligations, and accountability measures.

4 Monitoring & Oversight

Through regular reporting, communication, and monitoring visits, we track implementation, outcomes, compliance, and operational performance.

5 Financial Stewardship & Impact

We maintain detailed financial records and collect impact data, stories, photos, and videos to demonstrate transparency and results.

Accountability in Action

Strengthening Our Stewardship in Israel

Every donation you make deserves more than gratitude—it deserves accountability.

As part of IMFoC's commitment to governance, transparency, and donor accountability, Harold Heilbut, who served as President & CEO during FY2025/26, travelled to Israel to personally review projects supported by our donors. The visit was an important part of our ongoing oversight process, providing an opportunity to see the impact firsthand, verify progress, assess future needs, and ensure that each initiative continued to align with IMFoC's charitable mission.



Ziv Medical Center

At Ziv Medical Center in Safed, near Israel's northern borders, IMFoC-funded neonatal, ultrasound, and ENT equipment continues to improve care for the diverse communities of northern Israel.

Harold saw the equipment in use, met with hospital leadership, and reviewed additional priorities that could further strengthen specialized care.



Soroka Medical Center

The six ThermoCare K infant warmers funded by IMFoC are helping provide advanced care for vulnerable newborns while supporting the expansion of Soroka's new fortified Neonatal Care Centre.

During his visit, Harold reviewed their impact, toured the new centre, and discussed future equipment priorities.



Mayanei HaYeshua Medical Centre

The neonatal transport incubator supported by IMFoC is helping ensure newborns receive safe, specialized care from their very first moments of life.

Harold also toured the hospital's pediatric and trauma services while discussing future healthcare needs.

ZAKA Search & Rescue

IMFoC's partnership is strengthening emergency response capacity while supporting the emotional resilience of volunteers who respond to some of Israel's most difficult emergencies.

Harold met with ZAKA's leadership to review operational priorities and discuss future needs.



Arbel Institute

Leadership, resilience, and mental health programs are equipping educators, parents, and community leaders with practical tools to support children and families facing ongoing trauma.

Harold met with program leaders and participants to better understand the impact being achieved across communities.



Gvanim Association

Therapeutic and animal-assisted resilience programs are helping children and families recover from trauma and rebuild emotional well-being.

Harold met with the leadership team to review these initiatives and explore opportunities to expand their impact.
